# APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP - 2020

An application and portfolio submission is required for all applicants applying for scholarships in 2020. Scholarship applications will only be considered in conjunction with receipt of a completed Arndell Anglican College – Application to Enrol form. Scholarship applications are open to both current and future students, entering Year 7 or Year 11 in 2020.

## **Applications for all scholarships close 4pm Monday 4 February 2019.**

In 2020, Arndell Anglican College will be offering three scholarship categories as follows;

1. Academic Scholarship (*Year 7 & Year 11 2020*)
2. All Rounder Scholarship (*Year 7 2020 only*)
3. Performing Arts Scholarship (*Year 7 2020 only*)

Scholarships available cover all or part of a student's normal tuition fees for the period determined by the Headmaster. Scholarships do not include other expenses such as College service charges, uniforms, textbooks, or individual music tuition.

All awarded scholarships require students to maintain sound academic performance and may be reviewed by the College at any time throughout the life of the scholarship.

### **Important information regarding Academic Scholarships Applications**

All Academic Scholarships are assessed on the completion of the ACER Cooperative Scholarship Test. The Cooperative test date is **Saturday 23 February 2019**. Applications to sit this test open **Tuesday 4 September 2018** and close **Midnight AEDST Monday 4 February 2019**. This application form is to be used in conjunction with the application you make for the ACER Scholarship Program. Academic Achievement Portfolios should also be provided in support of your child's application. It is preferred that the applications not be bound or enclosed in folders or plastic sleeves. Please ensure documents are sighted and signed as originals by a Justice of the Peace.

Students applying for an 'All Rounder Scholarship' are encouraged to sit the ACER Scholarship Test. (See important information above). This application form is to be used in conjunction with the application form for the ACER Scholarship Program. Your child's portfolio outlining achievements and involvement in areas such as leadership, service, co-curricular activities and sport, should be supplied to support selected criteria. It is requested that this supporting evidence be supplied to the College as a copy of the original document, as scholarship submissions will not be returned. It is preferred that the applications not be bound or enclosed in folders or plastic sleeves. Photocopied documents must be attached ensuring that documents are sighted and signed as originals by a Justice of the Peace.

### **Important Information regarding Performing Arts Scholarship Applications**

This application form is to be provided in conjunction with your child's portfolio to support stated proficiency levels and pursuits. Your portfolio may include a short (no more than 5 minute) showcase of your child's abilities. Students who receive a scholarship are expected to contribute fully to the performing arts life of the College and undertake electives in a chosen arts field.

Shortlisted applications will be asked to attend an interview and audition to be held at the College in March/April 2019 where they will be asked to perform to a small panel. The audition will take approximately 20 minutes, with the student's choice of two performances.
